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AMENDMENTS

Amendments have been made to the following sections of the RFP issued on October 3, 2018:

ELIGIBILITY

Both stages of the competition are open to all shíshálh Nation members, which now includes those who may be employed by TKDC, provided they are not on the project team. Members who are also employees of the Nation or TKDC will continue to be excluded from any selection committee and the selection process. All submissions will be stored confidentially and only accessible to those named to the selection committee.

FINAL SELECTIONS

All information in this section remains the same, except that the timing and method of award presentations will be determined and communicated following completion of the RFP process, but is expected to take place no later than February 28, 2019.

HOW TO APPLY

All information in this section remains the same, except for the submission deadlines. Deadlines for submissions for both the design feature and the building name must now be received by TKDC no later than 2pm on Thursday January 10, 2019, to the attention of Jason Jenkins, EDO.

QUESTIONS & CLARIFICATIONS

The question period is now over, and aside from the changes noted in this addendum, no further questions or clarifications were received.

CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

Since both the Design Project and the Naming Contest are open to all shíshálh Nation members, including those employed by the Nation and TKDC, TKDC certifies that all pertinent information related to these proposal requests is contained within the original RFP and this addendum, and that employees have not been and will not be given further information so as to create a conflict of interest or unfair advantage.

All information related to the entire project is kept confidential and accessible only by those directly involved on the project or on the project team. By entering a submission to either proposal, the member and/or team indemnifies and saves harmless TKDC, the Nation, and staff members from any consideration, submission or event that might, in any way, be seen to be a conflict.
