As our annual volume under management continues to grow, Tsain-Ko Forestry Limited Partnership is seeking a motivated, safety-focused, and field-oriented Forestry Engineering Assistant to support our active coastal forestry operations.

## THE OPPORTUNITY

Reporting to the Area Engineer, the Forestry Engineering Assistant will support the surveying of cut blocks to identify key areas and determine suitable road locations. This position will assist with GPS surveying, road reconnaissance, cut block boundary layout, silviculture support, and timber reconnaissance activities. This role is ideal for someone who enjoys working outdoors, has strong attention to detail, is physically active, and thrives in a team-oriented field environment.

## THE DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conduct GPS surveys of streams, including the completion of stream identification cards.
- Perform GPS surveys of cut block boundaries, including establishing falling corners as required.
- Assist with road reconnaissance, road layout, and field surveying, including accurate note taking.
- Support cut block boundary layout activities.
- Assist with silviculture-related field and office work as required.
- Assist with timber reconnaissance to identify suitable areas for road and cut block layout.
- Support field planning and engineering activities while following safety standards and environmental practices.
- Work collaboratively with forestry, engineering, silviculture, and operations team members.
- Follow all company policies, safety procedures, and WorkSafeBC job procedures.
- Travel to and work across Tsain-Ko's land base and field operating areas on the Sunshine Coast.

## QUALIFICATIONS, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- Forestry experience, knowledge, or training is considered an asset.
- Knowledge of, or willingness to be trained in, navigational tools, maps, GPS, field applications, and computer systems.
- Basic computer proficiency, including Microsoft Office.
- Familiarity with forestry software such as ROADENG is considered an asset.
- Strong attention to detail and ability to maintain accurate field notes and records.
- Ability to work outdoors in all weather and terrain conditions.
- Must be physically fit, self-motivated, and comfortable performing field-based work.
- Ability to work well with others in a team environment.
- Strong communication, reliability, and organizational skills.
- Valid driver's licence and reliable transportation to the designated marshalling point each day are required.
